Position Summary

The MBAC/GEDD Rural Community Development Coordinator is a full-time position that will work in Broadwater and Meagher Counties and report to and assists the MBAC Executive Director. This position promotes economic vitality in the rural communities of White Sulphur Springs and Townsend within Meagher and Broadwater Counties. The position works with the MBAC team and partners with area public sector officials, financial institutions, chambers of commerce, economic development organizations, education facilities and community service organizations to deploy business and community assistance.

The position provides professional business and community development assistance including grant writing assistance, project development, and community outreach and needs analysis to both public, private and not-for-profit organizations in these communities.

This position is based in White Sulphur Springs and/or Townsend and the mission will be to catalyze community and business projects throughout the MBAC/Gateway Region: focusing on Broadwater, and Meagher Counties. Residency in either community is required.

- Be able to work independently, collaboratively, and efficiently with many state and federal programs, local government entities and the private sector of the region.
- Be able to organize and manage workflow with MBAC staff to meet goals and related requirements.
- Demonstrate strong interpersonal skills building positive and productive working relationships at MBAC and with related partners.
- Be organized and detail oriented.
- Be patient, thoughtful, and resourceful when thinking through challenges and making decisions.
- Have the ability to assess the personal character of individual partners and potential clients.
- Must be able to travel within the three county region, while focusing on daily activities in Broadwater and Meagher Counties.

- A Bachelor's degree or skills based experience in public administration, planning, business management, economics, manufacturing, engineering or related fields is required.
- Professional communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Excel in interpersonal interaction and coordination with staff, community members, residents, elected and appointed officials.
- Must be a self-starter.
- Must be proficient in Microsoft Office products with experience in Microsoft Project and other visualization programs preferred.
- Must show a commitment to business and community development.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
